The phone rings at Billy Bob's house:

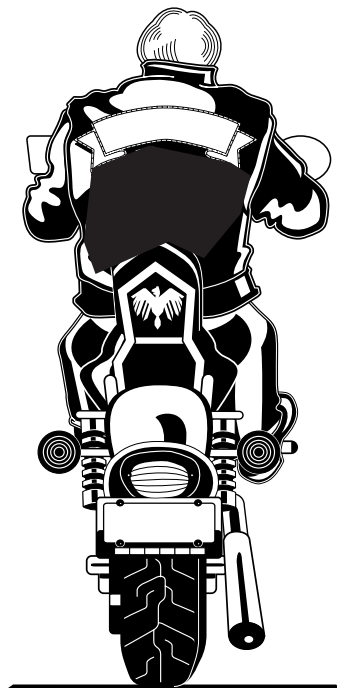
"Hey, Billy Bob! Did the FBI come?"
